In Thailand, seeking a family-friendly alternative to Bangkok's landmarks and traffic, Smiling Albino operates a new fleet of *Specialized* bicycles to bring guests into Bangkok's hidden canal communities and less-discovered historical sites.

"Since day one we've tried to offer experiences based on what we'd take our friends and family to see, and places outside the common sites. This year our good friends throughout the region have worked with us to help create some very exciting new adventures in Cambodia, Vietnam, and our home base in Bangkok", said Fraser, reclining in his planter's chair nursing a G&T.

Fraser will be traveling to **Calgary August 25-30, New York City September 3-9, and Toronto September 10-15** to talk about these innovative new tours and offer insight to the evolving luxury travel scene in Asia. He will also be hosting "[Destination Thailand](#)" Street Festival at Yonge-Dundas Square in Toronto on Sept. 12. All are welcome to visit for some authentic Thai food, beer, dance and culture.

An award-winning Thai television documentary host, Fraser is a notable face of Thai Tourism by filming the global Thailand ad campaign, as well as collaborating on such shows as BBC's *Hairy Bikers' Asian Adventure*. Daniel has been invited to speak at this year's prestigious PURE luxury travel event in Marrakesh, Morocco, in November.
